



Leadership Institute Application for Scholarship

The policy of Leadership Institute is to provide up to four scholarships to those candidates who are accepted into the program and demonstrate financial need, which will prevent participation. Each of the Chamber partners awards a scholarship to someone representing their area.

Consideration for scholarship is based primarily on demonstrated need. Priority is given to those candidates who are either employed in not-for-profit sector, not employed, or self-employed. Candidates employed by large, private sector companies would typically not be eligible. To be considered for a scholarship, you must complete the following information and submit it with your Leadership Institute application. Each scholarship recipient is responsible for the \$50 application fee and \$150 of the tuition.
